| Bible | Must include one year of each: Church History / The Life of Jesus / Old Testament / New Testament <br> Curriculum must provide evidence of understanding via quizzes, tests, or written assignments |

| History/Social Science | Must include World History, US History, Government/Economics |
| English | Must include writing assignments and reading of classic and modern literature |
| Mathematics | Must include 10 credits of Algebra |
| Science | Must include two of these four subjects: Physical Science, Biology, Chemistry, Physics <br> Must include laboratory activities |
| Foreign Language | Fulfilled by two years of the same language other than English |
| Visual/Performing Arts | Includes any of the following disciplines: dance, music, theater, visual arts or interdisciplinary arts |
| Physical Education | 200 minutes/week required: includes organized team sports, recreational classes, or an exercise log; Health class also accepted |
| Electives | Approved courses of student interest or extra category courses satisfy the elective requirements |
